



What do ECNL Club Fees Cover?

-  **Administrative & Registration**
 - Coaching Salary & Uniforms.
 - US Club player, team, team officials and coach registration & insurance.
 - Team Snap - Team/Club account.
 - Risk Management (Coaches, Chaperones & Team Managers).

-  **League and Showcase**
 - ECNL League Registration fees.
 - ECNL League game officials and assignment fees.
 - ECNL League hotel stay - out of state league games only hotel (Friday & Saturday night stays for Players, Team Manager/Chaperones & Coaches)
 - ECNL League - out of state league travel meals (Friday & Saturday night team dinners for Players, Team Manager/Chaperones & Coaches)
 - Coach travel costs (per diem, rental car/fuel if required, air flight etc.,)
 - ECNL Showcases Entry Fee

-  **Facility and Rental Costs**
 - Facility Rental expenses (training, scrimmage & games)
 - Facility and property insurance
 - Facility Equipment (goals, nets, rebounders, training aids)

-  **Other Costs**
 - Video Analysis Service & Video Equipment (new for 2018-19)
 - Parent & Coach education workshops (new for 2018-19)





What additional costs are there?

ECNL teams participate in the Southeast region with travel expected in the state of Florida and out of state for league play. Out of state league play is typically 2-3 weekends throughout the year. ECNL showcase attendance is mandatory for players and families will be responsible for all player travel expenses to and from it.



Orlando City Youth hosts the ECNL Winter Showcase at Seminole Soccer Complex. Doing this means you save money traveling. All ECNL players / families are expected to volunteer time during the Showcase to assist ECNL and OCYS run the Showcase.



other possible expenses include;

- Player brochures (printing costs).
- Team scrimmage referee fees (if applicable).
- Player meals (outside of team dinner on out of state league travel indicated in Club fees).
- Incidental costs during travel (laundry, entertainment, misc. snacks etc.)



Uniforms & Training Gear

Standard uniform cycles are every two years. Orlando City Youth Soccer Club next cycle begins in the 2019-2020 season. Returning players for 2018-19 will not purchase new uniforms, unless they choose too. New players are expected to purchase a kit.
